Returning to God

(ref. Deuteronomy 4:15-20,24, 1 John 4:16)

Leader: We are instructed, "watch yourselves very carefully, so that you do not become corrupt and make for yourselves idols – images in the shape of any living or earthly thing. And when you look up to the sky, and see the sun, the moon and the stars – the heavens arrayed – do not be enticed into bowing down to any of it, worshiping created things the Lord your God has made. For the Lord brought you out of the smelting furnace, out of slavery, to be the people of His inheritance."

All: We recall the covenant of the Lord, our God. We renounce our idols and return our trust to the Lord. We repent, remembering the Lord is a jealous God. God is love. God is a consuming fire.
